Angler of the Month

Biggest Fish of the Year

The Purpose of these contests is to give members the opportunity to compete when it is convenient for the angler to go fishing and encourage the turning in of fishing reports. Winners will be determined using fishing reports submitted and scored using the system below. Eligible species include

walleye, smallmouth, largemouth, pike, musky and trout. Contests will run from May through October.

Monthly Contest

The monthly contest will be awarded to the angler with the highest points for the best 5 fish. No more than 2 fish of one species will count towards total. Fish must be submitted through the website. Entries must be submitted by the 4th of the following month. Qualifying fish can be caught at any time on Lake Geneva, outings included.

Biggest Fish

At the end of the year the angler with the longest catch of each species will be given an award. This will be determined by submitted fishing reports with pictures. Ties will be broke on Angler of Year points

Angler of the Year

The angler with the most points for the six month contest will earn the title of Angler of the Year. All fishing reports must be submitted by November 4th.

Geneva Slam

Any angler that catches all 6 species will be a Geneva Slam winner.

Scoring System

1. Members are encouraged to report all fish caught while out fishing. The contest director will determine “up to” the best 5 eligible fish with a maximum of two from any one species of each month.
2. Entries must be measured to the nearest ¼ inch, if over round up to next ¼ inch.
3. When rounding up to nearest ¼ inch, fish must be least at minimum length to count.
4. Entries must have a photo with the participant holding the fish. If you are alone, the photo must clearly show the length of the fish on a bump board_or tape measure with the mouth closed.
The length of the fish must clearly and easily be determined by the contest director. No exceptions.
5. Points scoring will be determined by the following format:

Species	Minimum Size	Points Per Inch
Musky	40”	1.4
Northern Pike	30”	1.55
Walleye	20”	2.7
Largemouth Bass	17”	2.9
Smallmouth Bass	16”	3.2
Trout	20”	2.1
