CLEAR WATER MUSKIE & WALLEYE TACTICS

Captain Chris Taurisano took up fishing at a very young age when grandpa ventured to a local pond for bluegills and bullheads with Chris tagging along very willingly. Much of the family was into fishing a big way and they took Chris along for the catching. He was hooked and began reading every fishing magazine Chris could lay hands on and watching every fishing TV show he could find on the remote. Taurisano became so enthused about the sport he began saving money from allowances and odd jobs so that he could fish the local ponds to hone his angling skills.



Camp Fish was a fishing school started by the famous Al Lindner and the In-Fisherman crew where Chris had the opportunity to learn from the best in the business for a week out of every year for 5 years in a row! By 16 years old, he had his own boat and fished every week, many times with Grandpa, traveling all over the Midwest to different lakes and rivers, learning new waters and learning how to adapt to different situations and consistently put fish in the boat. Pro fisherman and guide Sean Bermingham took a liking to Taurisano helping Chris to become an even better and more well-rounded angler.

Captain Taurisano eventually began fishing tournaments and then decided to become a fishing guide as he wanted to teach others how to enjoy the great sport of fishing and be successful in their angling endeavors. Chris now spends about 300 days on the water, and ice, each year putting his clients on fish.

Known as one of the top guides for multi-species on the Fox Chain O' Lakes, Chris also guides for multi-species on other northern Illinois and southern Wisconsin lakes. This presentation will focus on Muskie and Walleye tactics Taurisano uses successfully with clients on Geneva and other clear water lakes.
