**Topic: *DNR Activity and
Developments on Geneva***

Luke Roffler is the Senior Fisheries Biologist covering Racine, Kenosha and Walworth Counties for the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. Luke last presented to our club in 2016 and has some exciting new developments to share. Roffler will be sharing recent monitoring and stocking results, as well as the justification behind an upcoming regulation change proposal for Geneva. This regulation change being proposed by the DNR for Geneva, will be discussed at the 2019 Conservation Congress Spring Hearings for Walworth County at Delavan-Darien High School on Monday, April 8th at 7pm.

With a resource like Luke, this will be a great opportunity to hear directly from the DNR about Geneva and other inland lakes and streams of southeast Wisconsin.
