

William Heim of Night Prowler Guide Service is a fishing guide on Wisconsin's Geneva and Delavan Lakes in Walworth Co. as well as Big Green and Pewaukee since 1992. He is an experienced multi species guide and someone you should know if you want to learn

how to fish these lakes year-round and day or night.

William was born in 1963 and grew up in Southeastern Wisconsin. His grandfather had him outside early in life and was hunting and fishing at age four. Heim recently became a full-time guide specializing in unique ways of teaching others how to adapt to the toughest conditions. With the walleye population growing on Geneva, William developed both daytime and nighttime techniques to catch this elusive species on Geneva's clear water. You also might want to book him for through the ice Lake Trout next winter.
