SEASONAL GAME FISH PATTERNS

Sam Veith is the current owner/operator of Fun Fishin' Guide Service on Geneva and Delavan Lakes: Sam's mission is all about giving back to Veterans and promoting fishing as a therapeutic activity to combat PTSD & mental illness. Many businesses and individuals funded guide trips for many veterans last year.

Veith grew up in the city, son of a Chicago fireman, and had minimal access to fishing (dad was not a fisherman). Annual family trips to Voyageurs National Park / Kabetogoma Lake spurred my love of fishing as a kid. He worked for Outdoor Network Web Design & Hosting after college which led to more connections in the fishing industry and brought Sam up to fish Geneva for the first time in my early 20s about 12 years ago.

He moved to Wisconsin 8 years ago to fish more and started part-time guiding last year in 2020. Sam's fishing education and experience also includes the Spence Petros Fishing School in 2008; being a First Mate aboard the Erie Drifter Sportfishing charter boat on Lake Erie for two seasons; and multiple guided trips with John Trossen, William "Billy" Heim and Steve Everetts on Geneva and Delavan.



Veith currently resides in Salem, WI with his wife Maria, baby daughter Rosalie born Halloween 2020.

His day job is a Commercial Insurance Broker specializing in Risk Management / Safety for Construction & Manufacturing with R&R Insurance Services, Inc., Waukesha, WI.

Sam's presentation will be cover various seasonal patterns for Geneva game fish. The presentation will include one of his favorite summer techniques which is drop shooting plastic worms for bass. Veith has also discovered and fine-tuned a HOT pattern on Geneva, the fall & winter trolling bite for walleyes – both numbers of fish and trophies.
