Mike Pehanich is a nationally known outdoor writer and owner of Small Waters Outdoors, his consulting and communications company. He is a regular contributor to Game & Fish publications and Major League Fishing's Bass Fishing magazine. He will share highlights — and insights — from that mind-opening adventure.
